1. Home examinations

- Ensuring the integrity of home exams; what is being done at home?

2. The kinds of questions that are set for home examinations

- Teaching people to write good questions for examinations
- Convincing them that setting good questions is worthwhile.
- Ensuring good questions for **all** examinations, and not just those on writing

3. Teaching students necessary skills

- Progression in skill development – teaching more complex skills later on
- Apprenticeship – assuming students must practice and develop their skills, not just have them instantly
- How to start teaching skills at an early stage

4. Reaching consensus / agreement within departments and within institutions

- Reaching consensus – especially on definitions
- How to reach consensus on what is right or wrong

- in different genres (example: in dissertations, reports, lab reports)
- On- line examinations
