

## **LEVEL 3: Reporting plagiarism**

Yes, if a teacher sees:

1. Evidence of attempts to conceal the true author of the work
2. Evidence of trying to create a false impression in the marker
3. Evidence that the student has been informed about how true work should be presented.

## **LEVEL 2: Managing plagiarized work**

1. Reduce the mark to show that the work does not meet the learning outcomes

**Plus**

2. call the student in for an interview with the teacher. This is to ensure the student understands what is incorrect and the consequences of continued failure to present 'true' work

**or**

3. call the student in for an interview with a specialist; ensure the student understands what is required and what will happen in future for this type of work. Keep a record of the interview.

**or**

4. (3. above ) + fail the work FX and require correction

**or**

5. (3 above) + fail the work F. The student must redo the assessment

## **LEVEL 1: Marking plagiarized work**

1. Reduce the mark to show that the assignment does not meet the learning outcomes

**and**

2. Inform the student in the feedback the grounds for reducing the mark
