"the branch of philosophy that deals with distinctions between right and wrong – with the moral consequences of human action" (Coughlin & Beauchamp, 1996)

- Effort to create the positive reflection on activities or intuition and moral choice which decided by someone

Code of Ethics in Anthropology


Code of Ethics of the American Anthropological Association

Approved June 1998

Anthropological Code of Conduct

- A. Responsibility to people and animals with whom anthropological researchers work and whose lives and cultures they study.
- B. Responsibility to scholarship and science
- C. Responsibility to the public


Code of Ethics in Anthropology
