Homework for seminar 2

This time you have a written assignment to complete:

Imagine a book project, "Images of Computer Science History". Your contribution should be three images with associated captions. The images could represent historical personages, milestones, problems or concepts but not unscientific events such as "Bill Gates becomes the richest man on earth".

You need not try to find the three most important events but they should at least be among those that every computer scientists should know about.

We hope that you don't all chose the same events. In order to prevent that happening we will give you some more personal instructions:

If you are born in January - March you should describe events concerning cryptography/security.

If you are born in April - June you should describe events concerning program languages and computation theory.

If you are born in July - September you should describe events concerning hardware.

If you are born in October - December you should describe events concerning applications of computers.

Bring and hand in a paper with the captions. We will want to show the accompanying images using a projector, so bring these on your computer, a memory stick or a URL. Be prepared to present your events and images.
